

INFO FOR SENIORS GRADUATION 2010

- **IDLA, Correspondence, PLATO, Alternate Route:**
Credits from IDLA classes, correspondence classes and the alternate route must be completed and verified with official transcripts by **Friday, May 7, 2010**, to ensure your name will be in the graduation program.
- **Semester Testing:**
Semester tests for seniors are set for **May 19-20-21** with Monday, May 24th scheduled as a make-up day.
- **Final Transcripts:**
Sign up in the Guidance Office for your final transcript, verifying your graduation, to be sent to your choice of college. **This is a must!**
- **Scholarship Recognition:**
Give a copy of your scholarship letters to Mrs. Lejardi by **May 21** so you can be recognized in the Graduation Program. We want to celebrate your success!
- **Locker Check out**
Locker check out will be held during 7th period on **Monday, May 24th** from 2:30-3:00 p.m. Students who do not check out of their locker will be fined \$5.00.
- **Fines/Fees/Senior Check out Form:**
 - All fine and fees must be paid by **Monday, May 24th**.
 - Your senior check out form must have all the appropriate signatures before you leave school on the **24th of May**.
 - Seniors who do not have all the signatures or turn-in their check out form to the high school office will not receive a diploma.
- **Graduation Rehearsal:**
 - Graduation rehearsal is set for **Monday, May 24th** from 5:00-6:30 p.m.
 - All seniors need to be in attendance.
 - Individual pictures and the senior class picture will be taken that evening.
 - Seniors must bring their caps and gowns for rehearsal and pictures.
- **Graduation:**
 - Graduation is set for **Saturday, May 29th** at 2:00 p.m.
 - Doors will open at 1:15 p.m. for general seating.
 - Reserved seating is not allowed.
 - The class video will run from 1:15 to roughly 2:00 p.m.
 - Graduation will start as closely to 2:00 p.m. as possible.
